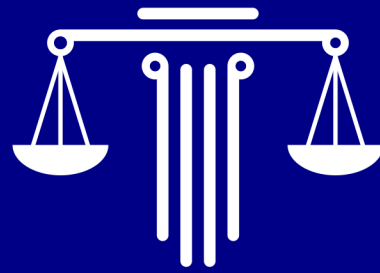
Our mission:

The Correctional Counseling Program provides misdemeanor probation monitoring, reporting, and multiple class options. All classes taught through CCI are instructed by trained and certified facilitators. Bilingual services are available.

CLASSES

DUI / ALCOHOL & DRUG AWARENESS

An evidence-based curriculum called "Prime for Life", is certified by the Tennessee Department of Mental Health. Prime for Life is designed for all ages, challenging common beliefs and attitudes that contribute to high-risk alcohol and drug use.

12 HR. DUI/ALCOHOL AND DRUG AWARENESS CLASS

DEFENSIVE DRIVING CLASS

Certified with the Tennessee Department of Safety and Homeland Security (License #1777) and Tennessee Highway Patrol Safety Education Division in accordance with the Tennessee Code Annotated T.C.A. 55-50-505.

4 HR. DRIVER EDUCATION CLASS: \$50 8 HR. DRIVER IMPROVEMENT CLASS: \$95



CCI Instructors are trained and certified by the American Automobile Association.

ANTI-THEFT COURSE

A 4-hour course designed to help offenders understand the real cost, repercussions, and penalties for offenses of theft.

- Uses "Something for Nothing" curriculum.



BATTERER'S INTERVENTION CLASS

Certified with the Tennessee Coalition to End Domestic and Sexual Violence. This class is an evidence-based approach to working with batterers with a strong focus on ending power and control issues with strategies for managing conflict and addressing oppression and violence against women. Designed for males and heterosexual offenders.

24 WEEK PROGRAM : 1-1.5 HOURS A WEEK

DOMESTIC VIOLENCE/ANGER MANAGEMENT

Domestic Violence class is for any offender who needs guidance in stopping abusive behavior.

- Uses "Bringing Peace to Relationships" curriculum.

24 WEEK PROGRAM : 1-1.5 HOURS A WEEK

Anger Management class is for any individual needing assistance coping with anger and emotion control.

- Uses "Coping with Anger" curriculum.

8 WEEK PROGRAM : 1-1.5 HOURS A WEEK

SERVICES

PROBATION , BOND MONITORING, DRUG SCREENINGS

Meetings with offenders occur on a regular basis. Monitoring and reporting to the court the progress, compliance, and status of offenders. Including but not limited to re-offenses, class completion, court cost payment, and compliance.

ALCOHOL AND DRUG ASSESSMENTS

Alcohol and Drug Assessments use the Substance Abuse Subtle Screening Inventory (SASSI).
