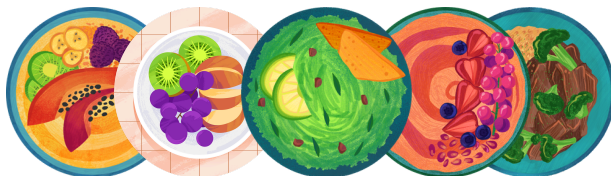
Summer Food Service Program

Who we are:

The Summer Food Service Program (SFSP) is a federally funded program that ensures children and teens continue to receive nutritious meals when school is not in session.

Each summer, the First Tennessee Human Resource Agency (FTHRA) provides free, healthy meals to children and teens 18 years and younger across Northeast Tennessee.

These meals ensure every child has access to the nutrition they need to learn, play, and grow.



Who We Serve:

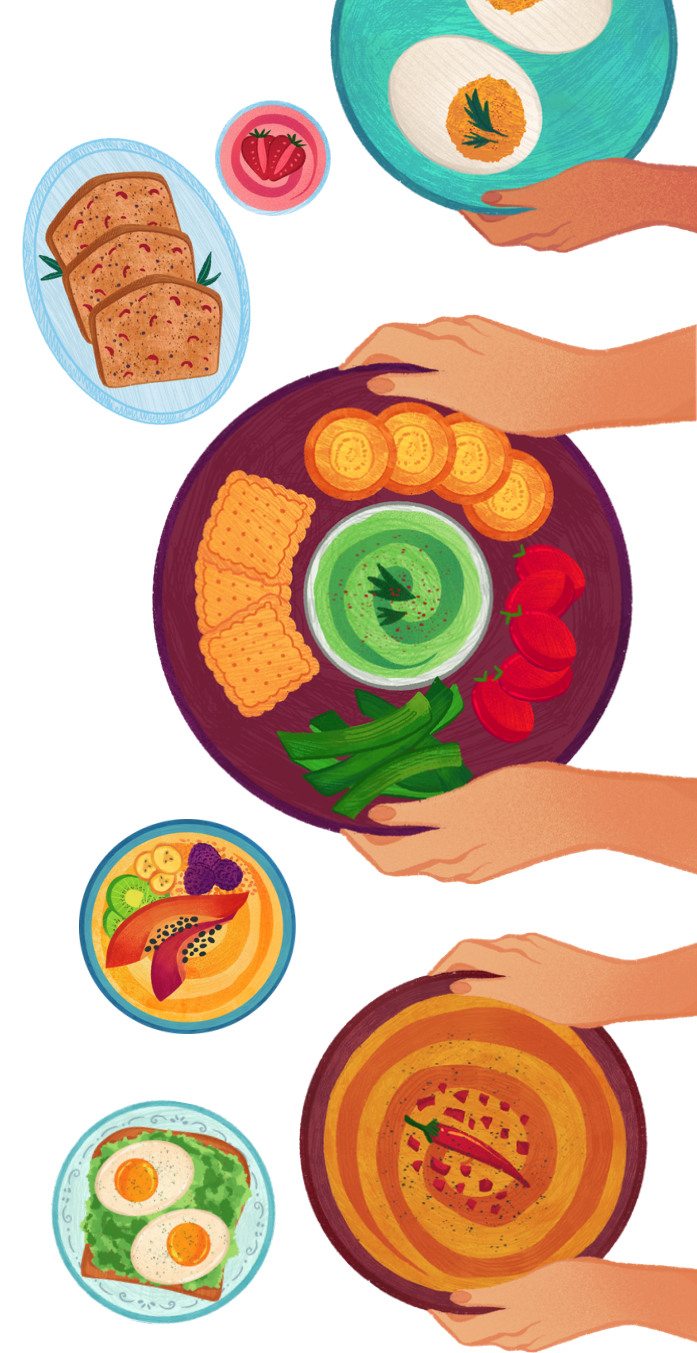
Any child or teen 18 years old or younger can receive a free meal — no registration or income requirements needed.

Meals are served at approved community locations, such as:

- Summer schools
- Parks and recreation centers
- Churches and libraries
- Community centers and housing sites

When Does It Run?

The program operates throughout the summer months, beginning shortly after the school year ends and continuing until classes resume.
